COUNCIL OF TRADE UNIONS OF CENTRAL ASIAN COUNTRIES

RESOLUTION

On current trends in trade union youth policy in the countries of Central Asia

In accordance with paragraph 14 of the Charter, the Council of Trade Unions of the Central Asian countries **DECIDES:**

1. To take into account the information of the national trade union centers (members of the Council) "On current trends in trade union youth policy in the countries of Central Asia".

2. Recommend to national trade union centers (members of the Council):

- to carry out a targeted policy towards youth in the economic and social spheres, to develop programs for involving young people in trade unions, to provide for the allocation of funds for work with youth in the budgets of trade union bodies at all levels;

- to seek from government structures at all levels, the business community the practical implementation of youth employment programs, ensuring socio-economic guarantees, solving housing problems, improving health and spiritual and moral education, familiarizing with a healthy lifestyle, creating normal conditions and wages, introducing new forms of professional development of young workers, adaptation of youth in labor collectives;

- take an active part in the development and activities aimed at improving the legal and regulatory framework in the field of youth policy;

- actively use the mechanisms of social partnership, ensuring the representation of young people in working groups and commissions for preparing proposals for draft agreements and collective agreements, conducting collective bargaining at all levels;

- to strengthen the information support of the work of trade unions with youth, to facilitate the opening of youth pages, headings in trade union newspapers and magazines, trade union bulletins on youth topics, to widely cover work with youth in trade union programs on radio and television;

- improve the system of training and education of young trade union leaders and youth trade union activists; ensure youth representation in all elected trade union bodies; include the most qualified young trade union activists in the personnel reserve for leading positions in trade union organizations at all levels;

3. Create a CTUCA Youth Council to develop partnership and cooperation between youth trade union structures in order to exchange information and experience of trade union work, provide advice on work with youth.
